Rules and Regulations:

1. Contestants must be a legal resident of Arkansas.
2. Contestants must be at least 1 year of age and not more than 6 years of age by the opening day of the Arkansas State Fair.
3. Winner 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Runner up will be awarded in each age group.
4. You must provide your own stick horse.
5. Attire can be anything western (cowboy or cowgirl themed) such as hats, boots, chaps, wrangler jeans, button down shirts, bandanas, etc. Attire must be in good taste and age appropriate. The dressing area for contestants will be inside the Arkansas Building. Each contestant must be accompanied by only ONE assistant backstage. No men will be allowed in the dressing area at any time. A separate dressing area for the boy contestants will be provided and the same rules apply to them.
6. Contestants have a 90 second time limit on stage. Appropriate country/western music will be played while contestants are on stage. All contestants ages 3 and under must have an adult with them on stage at all times. We will have a group line up before individual competition starts.
7. Contestants must turn in entry forms and fees by the deadline, October 1st, 2019.
Forms and
Fees may be mailed or hand delivered. If you are mailing your forms to the Fair Office please allow plenty of time for it to arrive, The Arkansas State Fair Office is not responsible for entry forms that may be lost or delayed in transit by shipping method.
8. Side Awards: Prettiest Hair and Prettiest Smile.
These awards are judged during the final line-up of contestants on stage. They are strictly extra awards that you may enter if you choose to. They are no bearing on the outcome of the pageant results.
9. The Arkansas State Fair and Arkansas Livestock Show Association are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please treat the facility with the upmost respect and clean up after yourself when the event is over.
10. Fair and impartial judges are chosen by the Arkansas State Fair and are not chosen by the director(s). Contestants and/or parents are not to approach the judges at any time. Their decision will be final. Score sheets will NOT be available at any time for viewing.
11. Any display of poor sportsmanship and/ or unbecoming conduct, any interference and/or disturbance, or any other behavioral problem or foul language created by a contestant, parent, relative, or supporter of a contestant could result in disqualification of the contestant not only from this year's contest but also from future participation.

12. **Admission and Parking:** Enter the fairgrounds thru Gate 11 (see map). Various groups may be arriving at this gate at the same time, including buses and livestock trailers, resulting in possible delays, please allow extra time. All must pay gate admission and parking fee. No permanent parking is available at the Arkansas Building. You will be allowed to park in the South parking lot. ***Please allow yourself extra time in this matter.***

13. You are allowed to compete in the pageant, talent and western wear competition. The western wear contest is a completely separate competition than the Little Mr. and Miss Arkansas State Fair pageant and Kids Talent Competition. You do not have to compete in the pageant to participate in the talent contest or western wear contest, but if you choose to do both you will be expected to fill out separate entry forms and pay separate entry fees.

14. The State Contest Director and/or State Fair Management of the Arkansas State Fair Kid's Talent Contest reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with, or incident to the contest, and the right to amend or add to these rules as their judgment may determine. Any contestant who fails to abide by any of the above rules can be disqualified from Contest by the State Contest Director and/or State Fair Management.
