SPECIAL AWARDS

THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR will award a Grand Champion Banner to the Grand Champion Wether Dam Goat in each division.

THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR will award a Reserve Grand Champion Banner to the Reserve Grand Champion Wether Dam Goat in each division.

SPECIAL RULES

A Wether Dam Goat is a crossbred animal, or may be purebred provided it is not tattooed, or entered in a 2019 ASF Breed Show.

No minimum or maximum weight.

Goats must be slick sheared (shorn above knees and hocks) before inspection.

Goats will be inspected by Arkansas Livestock and Poultry. Goats failing inspection will be removed from the fairgrounds immediately. These decisions are final and not subject to protest.

All Kid Goats must have baby teeth and yearling goats may have 2 or 4 permanent teeth.

Goats will be assigned to class by weight by show management.

Exhibitors will declare show weight on official ASF weight cards. There will be a random 5 lb. weigh back at the discretion of show management.

Goats must have scrapie tag.

Goats must be bedded on natural materials (no mats or carpets).

Exhibitors are limited to two entries per division.

Due to limited space availability, pen assignments are made for all livestock. Grooming and tack pens are not available. Pen sharing is required.

All exhibitors must comply with General Rules and Regulations and Special Junior Show specific rules. In addition, all exhibits must be in compliance with the Wholesome Meat Act and IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.
