SPECIAL RULES

1. All breeding sheep must be registered in their respective association and wear the assigned ear ID on their ear tag.
2. All animals must have an official scrappie ID tag.
3. Original registration papers must be presented at check-in.
4. Sheep in Spring Classes must have lamb teeth
5. Sheep in Fall Classes must have two permanent teeth not in wear
6. Yearling classes may have two or four teeth
7. Exhibitors may not receive more than two awards in any single class and not more than one award in any group class per breed
8. An exhibitor may move only one lamb from the Spring Class to the Fall Class.
9. Animals are subject to inspection by Arkansas Livestock and Poultry. Animals failing inspection will need to be removed from the fairgrounds immediately. Decisions by Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission officials are final and are not subject to protest
10. A breed must have ten animals and two exhibitors entered to have a show. Breeds not meeting this requirement will be moved to AOB classes.
11. All exhibits and exhibitors must comply with General Rules and Regulations and Junior Show specific rules and also be in compliance with the Wholesome Meat Act and IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics

1. Aged Ram Lamb (any ram too old for above classes, cannot be considered for Champion).....A
2. Yearling Ram (born after Sept.1, two years previous)..... A
3. Fall Ram Lamb (born September 1 to December 31, previous year) A
4. Spring Ram Lamb (born on or after January 1, current year)..... A
5. CHAMPION RAM (Winners of Classes 2, 3, and 4 compete) GRAND CHAMPION ROSETTE
6. RESERVE CHAMPION RAM.....RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION ROSETTE
7. Aged Ewe Lamb (any ewe too old for above classes, cannot be considered for Champion).....A
8. Yearling Ewe (born after Sept 1, two years previous) A
9. Pair of Yearling Ewes..... B
10. Fall Ewe Lamb (born September 1 to December 31, previous year) A
11. Early Spring Ewe Lamb (born January –February 15, current year) A
12. Mid Spring Ewe Lamb (born February 16-March 31, current year).....A
13. Late Spring Ewe Lamb (born on or after April 1, current year).....A
14. Pair of Ewe Lambs (Classes 10 - 13)..... B
15. CHAMPION EWE (Winners of Class 8,10-13 compete) GRAND CHAMPION ROSETTE
16. RESERVE CHAMPION EWERESERVE GRAND CHAMPION ROSETTE
17. Best Pair (Ram and Ewe, any age)..... B
18. Junior Flock (Ram Lamb, and two Ewe Lambs)..... B
19. Exhibitor's Flock (One ram any age, two yearling ewes, and two ewe lambs)..... B
20. Premier Exhibitor PREMIER EXHIBITOR BANNER
(The exhibitor winning the most money in the single classes will be the Premier Exhibitor. A minimum of three exhibitors and twelve animals shown in the division is required for this award to be presented)
